

Alberti Bass in C Major



Alberti Bass is a formula played in the left hand. Purely harmonic in effect, it does provide a simple contrapuntal effect to a melody. Named after 18th century composer Domenico Alberti (1710-40), it became a stylistic feature of 18th century and early 19th century keyboard compositions.
